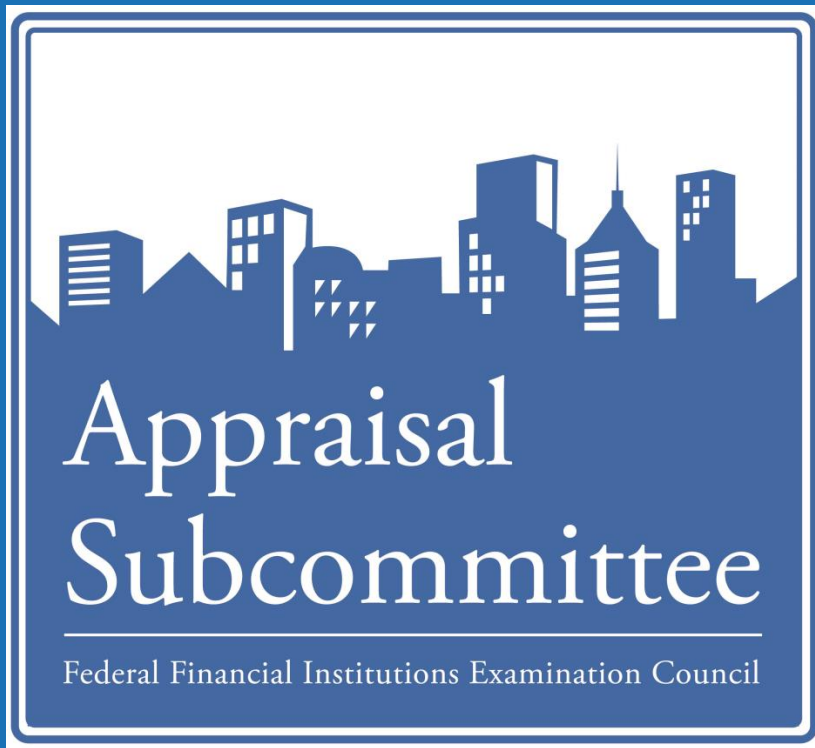

# Appraisal Subcommittee Core Functions



## **MONITOR**

state appraisal agency requirements

## **PERFORM**

compliance reviews of state appraiser regulatory programs

## **MAINTAIN**

national registry of appraisers and AMCs

## **MAKES GRANTS**

to the Appraisal Foundation and state appraiser certifying and licensing agencies

# ASC Grants Office Functions

- Establish funding priorities
- Issue Notices of Funding Availability (**NOFAs**)
- Review grant applications
- Make funding recommendations and awards grants
- Train/support grantees on federal grant requirements
- Monitors grantee activities (site visits/audits)

# ASC Grants – Statutory Authority

- ✓ Includes support for complaint processes, complaint investigations, and appraiser enforcement activities of such agencies
- ✓ Support to submit data to the *National Registries*
- ✓ *Activities that advance goals of Title XI*



# TYPES OF GRANTS

1

## NON-COMPETITIVE

3-year awards with 1-year operating Budgets  
\$25,000 to \$120,000 per year  
Rolling Quarterly Application Deadlines

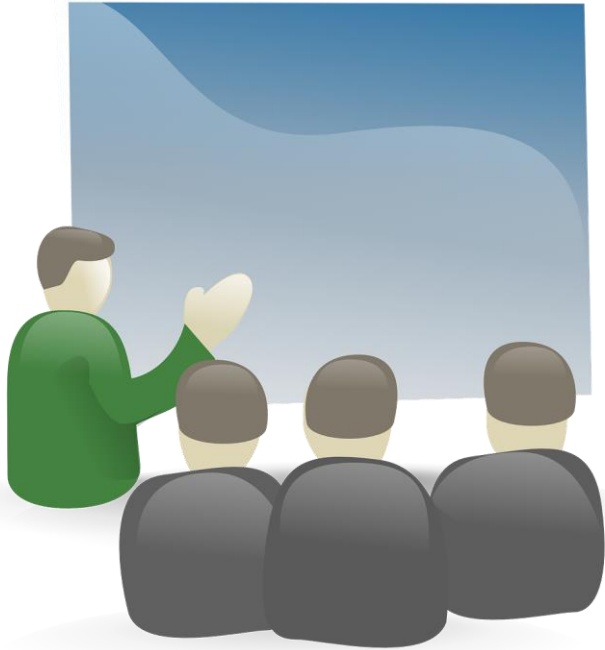
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## COMPETITIVE GRANTS

Demonstration Grants  
Special Initiatives

# COMPETITIVE GRANTS



- ✓ Support for innovation or demonstration grants designed to advance the appraisal industry
- ✓ Grantees can test assumptions and processes or solve critical problems
- ✓ Applications will define, test and disseminate conclusions about outcomes
- ✓ Limited Funds with specific application deadlines



# ALLOWABLE COSTS



- ✓ Three Part Test – Allowable, Allocable and Reasonable
- ✓ Grants can cover staff, facilities, equipment, supplies, training, consultants and other costs
- ✓ Application instructions will provide examples of eligible costs

# APPLICATION PROCESS



- ✓ Notices of Funding Availability (NOFA) will contain all the information potential applicants need to apply for funds
- ✓ Applicants need to register in the **System for Award Management (SAM)**

Grant Awards made Phase 1



# FEDERAL GRANT REQUIREMENTS

1

Grantees must follow federal grant requirements in the Code of Federal Regulations (**2 CFR 200**)

2

ASC will conduct training and provide Technical assistance for grantees on the grant admin. requirements

3

Awards management via HHS Payment Management System



# POST-AWARD GRANTS MANAGEMENT



Grantees will have accounts in the Payment Management System operated by the Department of Health and Human Services to:

- ✓ Withdraw grant funds from their accounts as they need them
- ✓ Submit financial and progress reports

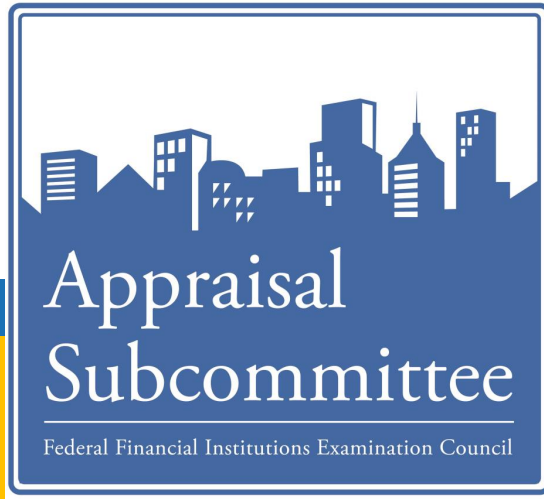
